### ..Explanation

**BACKGROUND:** This legislation authorizes the Finance and Management Director to renew an existing Universal Term Contract (UTC) for the option to obtain Traffic Sign Posts and Street Name Sign Posts with MD Solutions Inc. This contract provides for traffic sign posts for all traffic signs, delineators and street name signs citywide for the Division of Traffic Management.

The contract, PO076706, was established in accordance with Request for Quotation RFQ002888 and authorized under Ordinance Number 0052-2017 and will expire July 1, 2020. In accordance with the bid specifications, the City and MD Solutions Inc. can renew the contract for an additional one year term subject to mutual agreement and approval of proper City Authorities. The new contract expiration date will be July 1, 2021.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** No funding is required to renew the option contract. The Department of Public Service must set aside their own funding for their estimated expenditures.

To authorize the Finance and Management Director to renew a Universal Term Contract for the option to purchase Traffic Sign and Street name sign posts with MD Solutions, Inc.

**WHEREAS,** the Purchasing Office entered into a Universal Term Contract for Traffic Sign and Street name sign posts for use by the Division of Traffic Management; and

**WHEREAS,** this contract was entered into in accordance with Chapter 329 of the Columbus City Code, pursuant to solicitation RFQ002888, with MD Solutions, Inc. deemed the lowest, most responsive, responsible and best bidder, and

**WHEREAS,** in accordance with the bid specifications, the City and MD Solutions Inc. can renew the contract for an

additional one year period, subject to mutual agreement and approval of proper City authorities, and

**WHEREAS**, it has become necessary in the usual daily operation of the Department of Public Service to authorize the Finance and Management Director to renew a Universal Term Contract with MD Solutions, Inc. for the option to obtain Traffic sign and Street name sign posts; **now, therefore**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS:**

**SECTION 1.** That the Finance and Management Director is hereby authorized to renew the option contract with MD Solutions, Inc., PO076706, for a period of one year, from July 1, 2020 to and including July 1, 2021.

**SECTION 2.** That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
