WHEREAS, we encourage everyone to register and fundraise for the Nationwide Children's Hospital Columbus Marathon & $\frac{1}{2}$ Marathon, so that one day we can celebrate finding cures for all of the patients. Dedicate your race to the kids helped by this incredible institution, by running or walking 13.1 or 26.2 miles; and
