..Explanation

BACKGROUND: This legislation authorizes the Finance and Management Director to establish a Universal Term Contract (UTC) for the option to purchase Longitudinal Channelizers with Qwick Kurb. The Division of Traffic Management is the primary user for traffic control devices. Longitudinal Channelizers are used to divert traffic on City streets. Qwick Kurb is the sole source for these parts and services as they are the only local distributor and authorized service provider for this specific manufacturer. Pricing was obtained by submitting a specification and proposal page to the vendor, Qwick Kurb. The term of the proposed option contract would be approximately 3 years, expiring December 31, 2025, with the option to renew for one (1) additional year. In addition, the expenditure of \$1.00 is hereby authorized from General Budget Reservation BRPO002025.

Total Estimated Annual Expenditure: \$50,000.00, Division of Traffic Management, the primary user

WHEREAS, the Longitudinal Channelizers UTC will provide for the purchase of lane seperators and channelizer

systems used to modify and reroute lanes on City streets and Qwick Kurb is the sole source provider of these goods and services; and,

WHEREAS, it has become necessary in the daily operation of the Department of Public Service to authorize the Finance and Management Director to enter into a Universal Term Contract for the option to purchase Longitudinal Channelizers with Qwick Kurb; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS:

SECTION 1. That the Finance and Management Director is hereby authorized to enter into the following Universal Term Contract for the option to purchase Longitudinal Channelizers for a term of approximately three (3) years, expiring December 31, 2025, with the option to renew for one (1) additional year, as follows:

Qwick Kurb, \$1.00

SECTION 2. That the expenditure of \$1.00 is hereby authorized from General Budget Reservation BRPO002025 of this ordinance to pay the cost thereof.

SECTION 3. That this purchase is in accordance with relevant provisions of the Columbus City Code, "Sole Source Procurement."

SECTION 4. That the funds necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance are hereby deemed appropriated, and the City Auditor shall establish such accounting codes as necessary.

SECTION 5. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
