To Recognize and Celebrate Ohio Loves Transit Day on February 14, 2018

WHEREAS, on February 14, 2018, the Ohio Public Transit Association (OPTA) is promoting a statewide initiative to celebrate Transit in Ohio how and how it is helping move Ohio forward; and

WHEREAS, public transportation can provide a better quality of life to every community in central Ohio including: individuals, families, children, seniors, and persons living with disabilities and is a one of many critical solutions for our region's economic, energy, and environmental challenges; and
