BACKGROUND: The purpose of this ordinance is to repeal Resolution 0107X-2021. On June 28, 2021 the City passed Resolution 0107X-2021 declaring the necessity and intent to appropriate real estate in conjunction with the Department of Public Service's Roadway Improvements - Little Turtle Way Project (Project Number 531002-10000). The Department of Public Service has determined that the real estate is no longer required to complete the project and is now requesting that the resolution be repealed.

EMERGENCY DESIGNATION

Emergency action is requested to repeal resolution 0107X-2021 since the real estate is no longer needed to complete the project.

To repeal Resolution 0107X-2021 declaring the necessity and intent to appropriate real estate in conjunction with the Department of Public Service's Roadway Improvements - Little Turtle Way Project; and to declare an emergency (\$0.00)

WHEREAS, on June 28, 2021 the City passed Resolution 0107X-2021 declaring the necessity and intent to appropriate real estate in conjunction with the Department of Public Service's Roadway Improvements - Little Turtle Way Project; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Service has determined that the real estate is no longer required to complete the project and is now requesting that Resolution 0107X-2021 be repealed; and **now, therefore**

WHEREAS, an emergency exists in the usual daily operation of the Department of Public Service in that it is immediately necessary to repeal resolution 0107X-2021 since the real estate is no longer needed to complete the project, thereby preserving the public health, peace, property, safety and welfare; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS:

SECTION 1. That Resolution 0107X-2021 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law. That for the reasons stated in the preamble hereto, which is hereby made a part hereof, this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor or ten days after passage if the Mayor neither approves nor vetoes the same
