WHEREAS, a C.O.P.E. School Graduate actively involved in lobbying the United States General Assembly as well as the President to reform labor and immigrant issues. He is also a Civil Rights Designee, having attended regional and national Civil Rights conferences; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Lacey is Assistant to the President of the A. Phillip Randolph Institute Educational Conference, assistant to the National Board member and the Chair of the NAACP Image Awards show, Executive Board Member of the Columbus Chapter of the Coalition Black Trade Unionists, and Executive Board Member of the Columbus Chapter of the A.
